Welcome to this year's Life Orientation course.

I want to thank all the learners who have already sent in all the assessment tasks for this year. Your marks are available at Delta or from me (you may contact me).

The learners who have not yet done any assignments, should note the following:

- Your only obligation is to complete your assessment tasks and to send them in. They are your portfolio.
- Please send in the tasks as soon as possible. The assessment tasks are allocated to different terms to give the learners more time. They should be handed in at the end of each term, or sooner if possible. The mark sheet with the end of term dates is included once again.
- The tasks are not returned to you because they are bound and handed to the department where they are moderated and kept. Therefore, please make copies of the assignments as proof that they have been completed.
- Please remember that no final exam in Life Orientation will be written in November. You are going to write only two exams, the first one in June and then the Record Exam as the final exam in August. Both these exam papers will cover the entire year's work. These are not open book tests.
- Since the final mark will be determined after the Record Exam and sent to the Department of Education together with all the assessment tasks, no late assessment tasks can be accepted. The Department of Education will moderate the portfolios as soon as they are handed in.
- No auxiliary exam will be written in Life Orientation, since the exam paper is merely a part of the whole year's portfolio. Therefore the whole year will have to be repeated.
- No learner will be allowed to write the Record Exam if all the assessment tasks have not been handed in.
- The learner must achieve at least 50% in Life Orientation for admission to a university.
- If a learner fails Life Orientation, the learner also fails matric. Life Orientation is a prerequisite for matric.
